## LOCAL STANDOUT FILLY EVERLAND HEADLINES \$125,000 WINTERGREEN STAKES

**FLORENCE, Ky. (Saturday, Feb. 22, 2025)** – Foster Family Racing, William Wargel, R.K. Eckrich Racing and Maxis Stables' multiple stakes winning filly Everland will face eight rivals as the headliner in Saturday's 39<sup>th</sup> running of the \$125,000 Wintergreen Stakes at Turfway Park Racing & Gaming.

Run at one mile, the Wintergreen Stakes will go as Race 7 of 10 with a post time of 8:55 p.m. (all times Eastern). First post is 5:55 p.m.

A four-time winner over the Turfway Park surface, Everland enters the Wintergreen following a determined half-length victory in the Likely Exchange Stakes four weeks ago. Trained by **Eric Foster**, the 4-year-old daughter of Arrogate won last year's Bourbonette Oaks to qualify for the 150<sup>th</sup> running of the Longines Kentucky Oaks (GI), where she finished fifth. **Abel Cedillo** will ride from post No. 9.

Other top contenders in the race include eight-time winner **Sand and Sea**, four-time winner **Dreaming of Mo** and South Florida shipper **Austere**, winner of the 2023 Juvenile Fillies Stakes at Kentucky Downs.
